## General Information

You will be housed in a college dorm in the northeast corner of the main campus. Meals will be planned by professional dieticians and served in the residence hall dining room. Bedding and towels will be provided. Please bring only small amounts of cash for souvenirs or treats. Expensive jewelry, watches, clothing or other valuables should not be brought to Camp. We suggest you bring an alarm clock, fan, personal toiletries, shower shoes, robe, and shorts and T-shirts for fun. **Participants will be supervised by counselors day and night.**

## Commuter Plan

For those of you who live in the local area and do not wish to stay overnight, a commuter plan is available. Commuters are required to check in on Sunday evening and attend the briefing session. All participants are required to eat lunch in the residence hall.

## Financial Aid

A limited number of partial scholarships are available. Campers should fill out the Camp application and attach 2 letters of recommendation from their teacher/principal and their own letter stating why they want to come to Camp. Financial Aid materials should be sent to Barb Stinnett at the address shown on the Camp application. ## Medical Policy

Each participant is required to have medical insurance. Any accident or illness will be treated at a local health facility and parents will be notified. For billing purposes, each participant must have an insurance card and/or insurance numbers with them.

All campers must attend all sessions and comply with the rules and regulations of Michigan State University governing conduct of students on the campus. Any violation or abuse of these rules will result in immediate dismissal

## Refund Policy

Cancellation requests must be made in writing. **Fifty dollars (\$50) of the camp fee is non-refundable.** The balance will be returned upon completion of processing up to two weeks prior to camp (June 30, 2008). After that, no refund will be made without a certified doctor's excuse.

## Advanced Program

For those of you who have attended camp before and would like to take your experience a step further, an Advanced Program is available. This program, will give you an opportunity to spend time in the lab with some experiments and also visit the Kellogg Biological Station for some outstanding aquatic collecting.
